## Widening of I-215

The Henderson I-215 Project has several updates to the area, including:

- **I-215 Pecos to Stephanie**

- Storm drains have been installed and work has begun on retaining walls
- Hours of Construction: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday night through Friday morning
- During the day, three lanes will be open in each direction. At night, there will be lane reductions as needed.

- **1-215 Ramps**

- 1-215 eastbound off-ramp to Pecos will have storm drain installation starting in late September/early October. There will be lane restrictions on the off-ramp.
  - Hours of Construction: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday night through Friday morning.
- 1-215 westbound off-ramp to Pecos will have storm drain installation starting in late September/early October. There will be lane restrictions on the off-ramp.
  - Hours of Construction: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday night through Friday morning.

- **Surface Streets**

- Paseo Verde Pkwy. at St. Rose Pkwy will have installation of conduit, traffic signals will be relocated and light pole foundations will be created. Lane restrictions will be on Paseo Verde Pkwy and northbound St. Rose Pkwy.
  - Hours of Construction: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday night through Friday morning.
- St. Rose Pkwy at 1-215 will be receiving traffic signal modifications. There will be lane restrictions on St. Rose Pkwy with daytime restrictions possible.
  - Hours of Construction: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday night through Friday morning.
- Green Valley Pkwy, between 1-215 and Village Walk Dr. will have potholing from late September/early October. There will be lane restrictions on Green Valley Pkwy. for a few nights.

- **Bike Paths & Trails**

- 1-215 Trail off of Green Valley Pkwy. to Valle Verde Dr. will be closed through mid-October. There will be a detour to Paseo Verde Pkwy.
- 1-215 Trail off Arroyo Grande Blvd to Stephanie St. will be closing in October. There will be a detour to Paseo Verde Pkwy.
- The bike path on St. Rose Pkwy between Coronado Center Dr. and Paseo Verde Dr. will be closed long-term.
