It is always a great time on Water Street. I spent an afternoon at Hot Rod Days on Water Street where I got to see some incredible cars, including my dream car, a Vet.

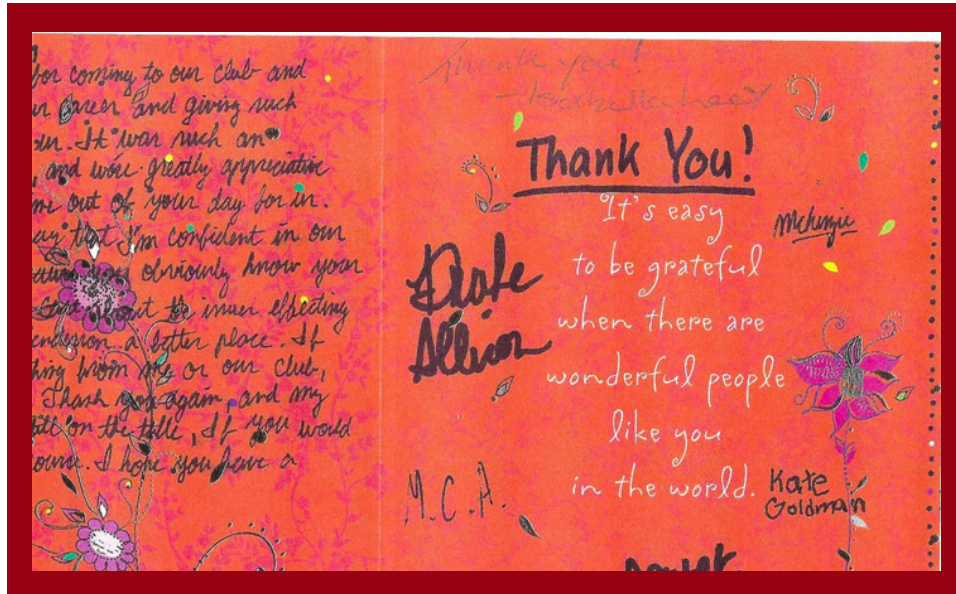


National Night Out with the Community

Thank You Card from Coronado High School



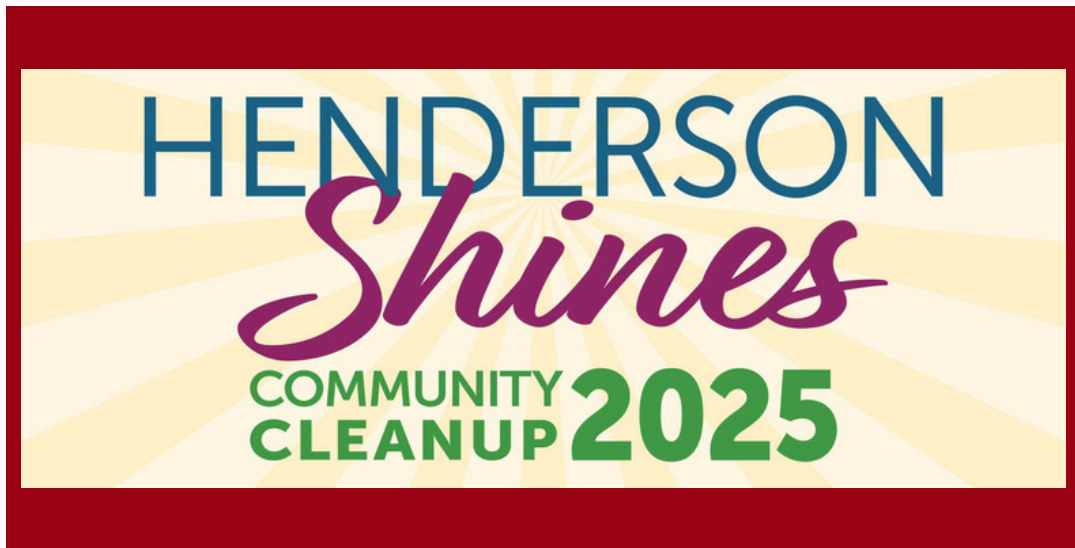

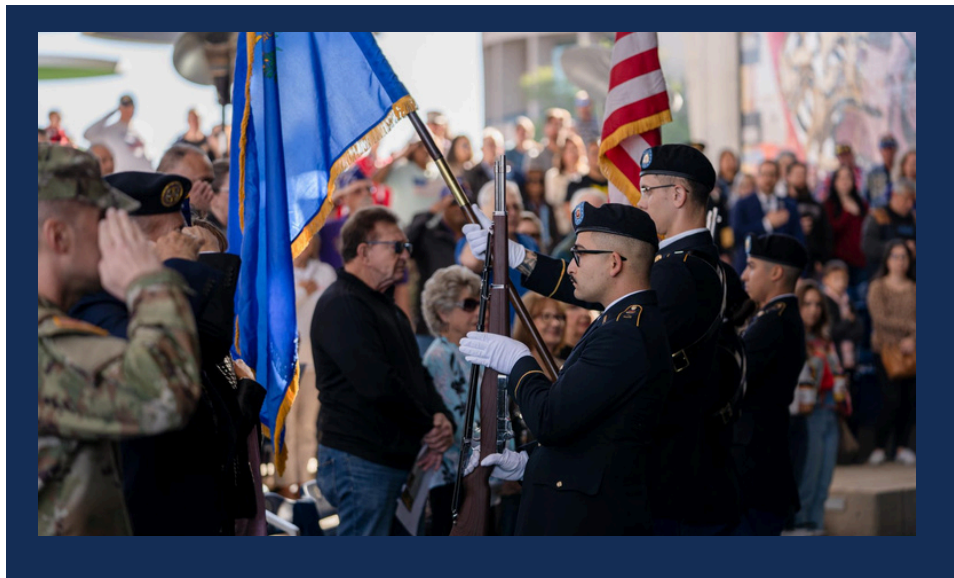
