Home is Nevada



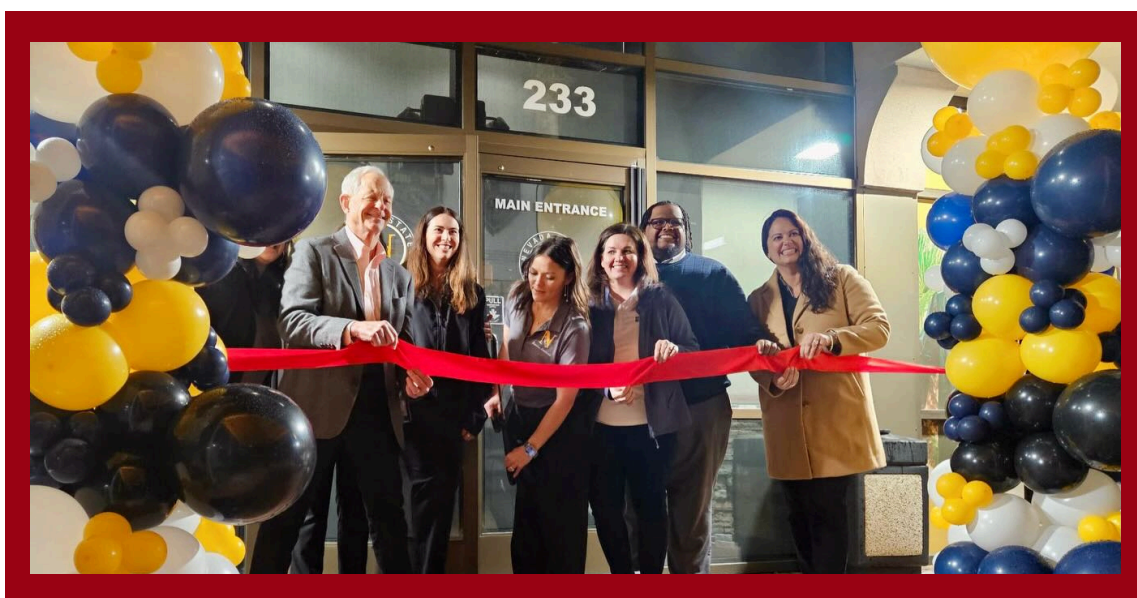

Widening of I-215

Construction Updates for the weeks of February 22 & March 1:

Expect the following traffic impacts between 9pm-6am nightly from Sunday night to Friday morning

I-215

- Speed limit reduced to 55mph

-

St Rose Pkwy to Stephanie St

- Upgrading of high-mast lighting to LED, storm drain install, removals, retaining and sound walls, ITS, excavation for widening
 - Lane reductions at night, as needed

Ramps

- I-215 Westbound and Eastbound off-ramps to Pecos Rd/St Rose Pkwy
 - Storm drain install, ramp widening
 - Lane restrictions on the off-ramps

Surface Streets

- Paseo Verde Pkwy, Village View Dr to St Rose Pkwy
 - Intersection realignment
 - Lane Restrictions
- St Rose Pkwy/Pecos Rd, Coronado Center Dr to Paseo Verde Pkwy
 - Extended right turn lanes feeding onto eastbound I-215 now open

Bike Paths & Trails

- I-215 Trail, Green Valley Pkwy to Valle Verde Dr
 - Soundwall installation
 - Long-term closure
 - Detoured to Paseo Verde Pkwy
- I-215 Trail, Arroyo Grande Blvd to Stephanie St
 - Retaining walls
 - Long-term closure
 - Detoured to Paseo Verde Pkwy

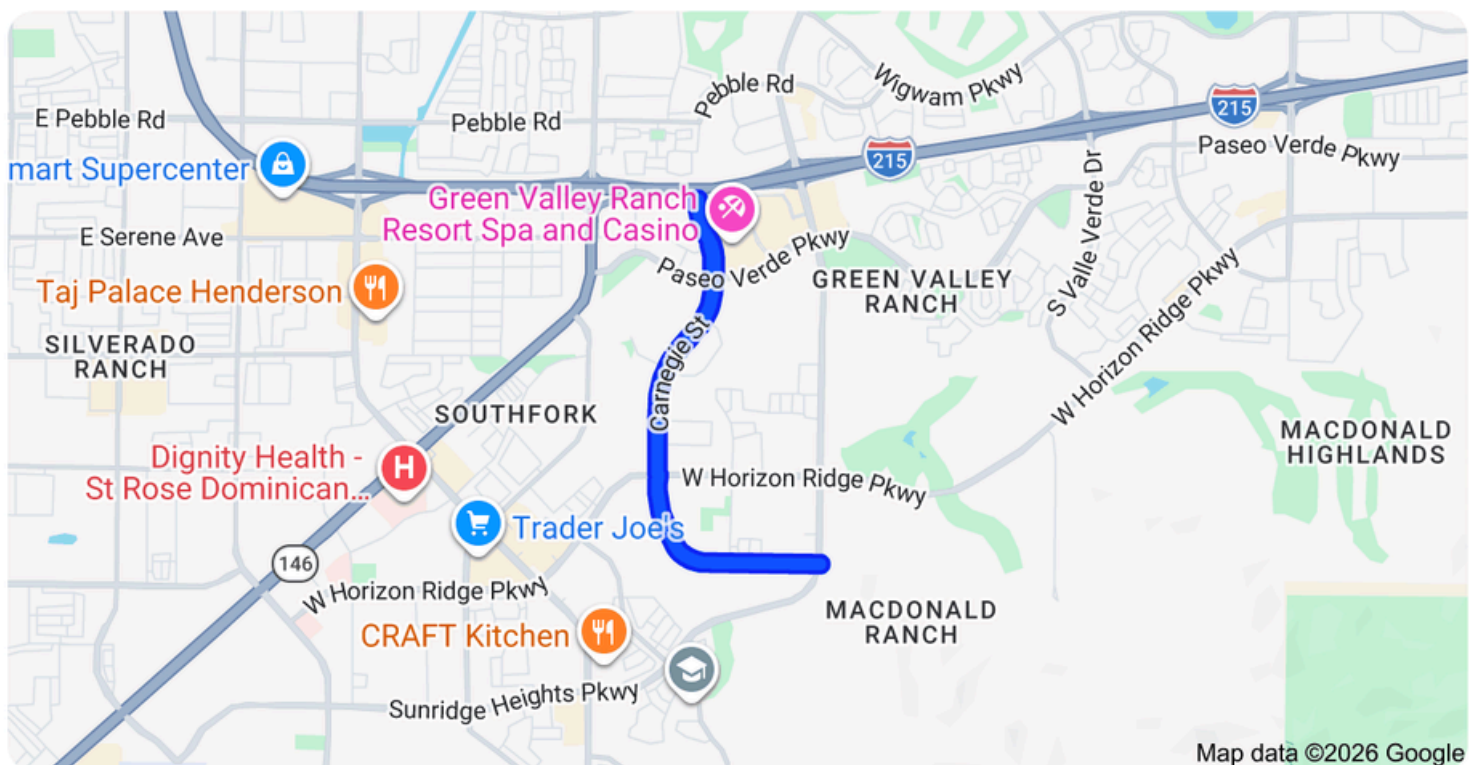

Carnegie Street Re-Paving Project Update

Advertising for the Carnegie Roadway Project will be going out this week. The project will construct roadway rehabilitation improvements along Carnegie Street between Green Valley Parkway and Paseo Verde Parkway, adding a new traffic signal at the south intersection of Carnegie and Cozy Hill Circle.

The project will include mill and overlay of existing pavement, full depth asphalt pavement, crack sealant, median islands, sidewalk, curb and gutter, sidewalk ramps, driveways, traffic signing, pavement markings, traffic signal modifications and new installations, school flashers, utility and storm drain adjustments and other associated improvements.

We are also updating two existing RRFBs at Annet Street and north Cozy Hill and adding a new RRFB at the Anthem Rose Trail crossing. We are purposely advertising at this time to get the project positioned to be able to start once school is out in those difficult portions around existing schools.
