# Widening of I-215

## **Construction Updates for the weeks of Weeks of March 22 and 29:**

Expect the following traffic impacts between 9pm-6am nightly from Sunday night to Friday morning

### **I-215**

- Speed limit reduced to 55mph
- St Rose Pkwy to Stephanie St
  - *Upgrading of high-mast lighting to LED, storm drain install, removals, retaining and sound walls, ITS, excavation for widening*
    - Lane reductions at night, as needed

### **Ramps**

- I-215 Eastbound off-ramp to Stephanie St
  - *Retaining walls and ramp widening*
  - Lane restrictions on the off-ramp
- I-215 Westbound and Eastbound off-ramps to Pecos Rd/St Rose Pkwy
  - *Storm drain install, ramp realignment*
  - Lane restrictions on the off-ramps

### **Surface Streets**

- Paseo Verde Pkwy, Village View Dr to St Rose Pkwy
  - *Median island installation*
  - Lane restrictions

### **Bike Paths & Trails**

- I-215 Trail, Green Valley Pkwy to Valle Verde Dr
  - *Soundwall installation*
  - Long-term closure
  - Detoured to Paseo Verde Pkwy
- I-215 Trail, Arroyo Grande Blvd to Stephanie St
  - *Retaining walls*
  - Long-term closure
  - Detoured to Paseo Verde Pkwy
