Save the Date – Tabernacle Choir Watch Party at Lee Family Forum on June 26<sup>th</sup> – more to come.

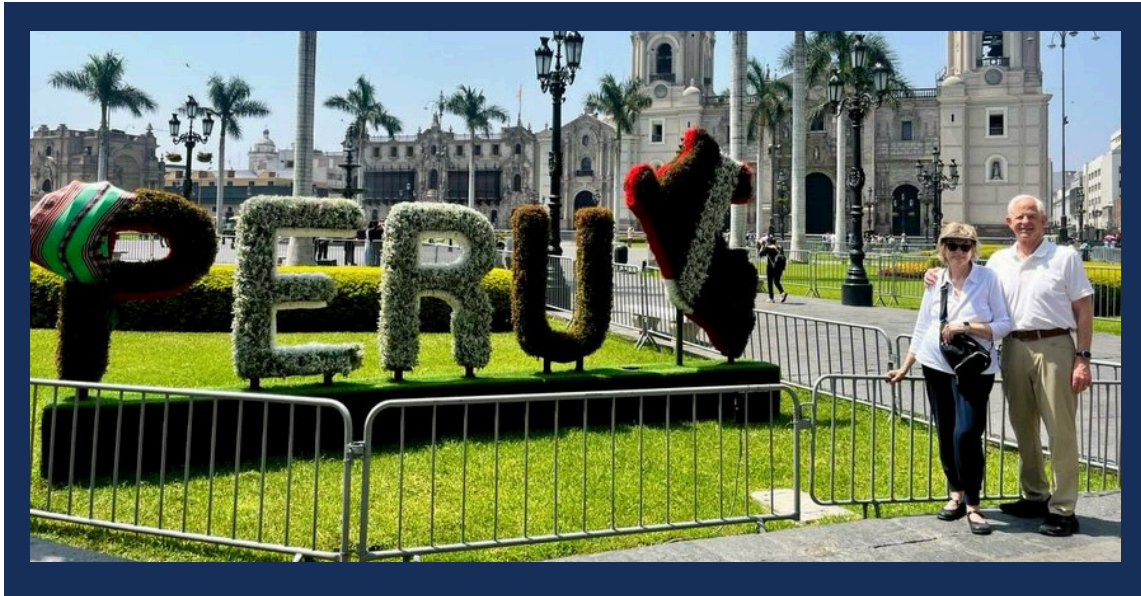

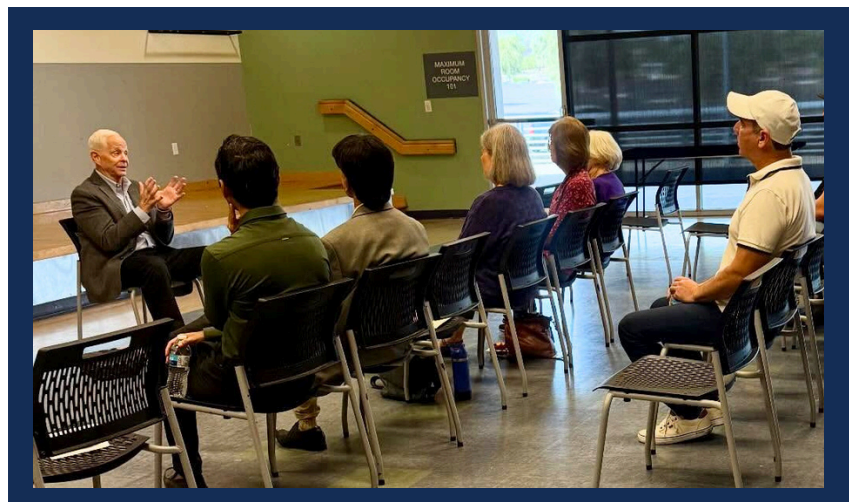
## Intermountain Children's Hospital

# Widening of I-215

## **Construction Updates for the weeks of Weeks of April 19 and 26:**

Expect the following traffic impacts between 9pm-6am nightly from Sunday night to Friday morning

### **I-215**

Speed limit reduced to 55mph

St Rose Pkwy to Stephanie St

- *Asphalt and concrete paving, upgrading of high-mast lighting to LED, storm drain install, removals, retaining and sound walls, ITS, excavation for widening*
  - Lane reductions at night, as needed

### **Ramps**

I-215 Eastbound off-ramp to Green Valley Pkwy

- *Storm drain installation*
  - Lane restrictions on the off-ramp
  -

I-215 Eastbound off-ramp to Stephanie St

- *Retaining walls and ramp widening*
  - Lane restrictions on the off-ramp

I-215 Westbound and Eastbound off-ramps to Pecos Rd/St Rose Pkwy

- *Sound walls, traffic signals, storm drain install, ramp realignment*
  - Lane restrictions on the off-ramps

### **Surface Streets**

Southbound Green Valley Pkwy, Corporate Circle to south of Village Walk Dr  
*NV Energy work*

- Nighttime lane restrictions (9pm-6am)
- May be reduced to one lane at night, as needed
- Pedestrians detoured to northbound Green Valley Parkway. See website for details

St Rose Pkwy at Paseo Verde Pkwy & Paseo Verde Pkwy, Village View Dr to St Rose Pkwy

- All lanes open by April 20th

### **Bike Paths & Trails**

I-215 Trail, Valle Verde Dr to St Rose Pkwy

- *Soundwall installation, NV Energy work*
  - Long-term closure, including trail connection at Dos Escuelas Park
  - Detoured to Paseo Verde Pkwy

I-215 Trail, Arroyo Grande Blvd to Stephanie St

- *Retaining walls*
  - Long-term closure
  - Detoured to Paseo Verde Pkw

Please note City Hall will be closed Memorial Day.
