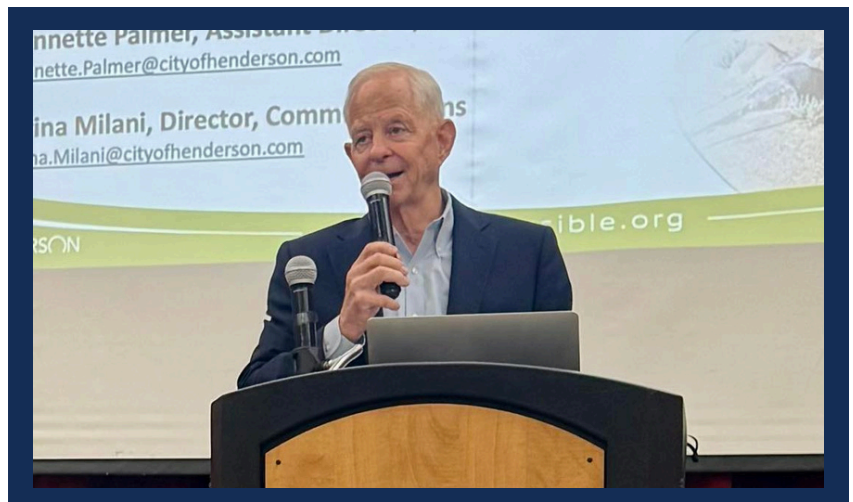
Penta Building Group Headquarters

Widening of I-215

Construction Updates for the week of May 17 and 24:

Expect the following traffic impacts between 9pm-6am nightly from Sunday night to Friday morning:

I-215

Speed limit reduced to 55mph

St Rose Pkwy to Stephanie St

- *Asphalt and concrete paving, upgrading of high-mast lighting to LED, storm drain install, removals, retaining and sound walls, ITS, excavation for widening*
 - Lane reductions at night, as needed

Ramps

I-215 Eastbound off-ramp to Green Valley Pkwy

- *Storm drain installation*
 - Lane restrictions on the off-ramp

I-215 Eastbound off-ramp to Stephanie St

- *Retaining walls and ramp widening*
 - Lane restrictions on the off-ramp

I-215 Westbound and Eastbound off-ramps to Pecos Rd/St Rose Pkwy

- *Sound walls, traffic signals, storm drain install, ramp realignment*
 - Lane restrictions on the off-ramps

Surface Streets

Southbound Green Valley Pkwy, Corporate Circle to south of Village Walk Dr

- *Removals, NV Energy work*
 - Nighttime lane restrictions (9pm-6am)
 - May be reduced to one lane at night, as needed
 - Pedestrians detoured to northbound Green Valley Parkway. See website for details

Bike Paths & Trails

I-215 Trail, Valle Verde Dr to St Rose Pkwy

- *Soundwall installation, NV Energy work*
 - Long-term closure, including trail connection at Dos Escuelas Park
 - Detoured to Paseo Verde Pkwy

I-215 Trail, Arroyo Grande Blvd to Stephanie St

- *Retaining walls*
 - Long-term closure
 - Detoured to Paseo Verde Pkwy

Election Day



Election Day for Henderson's Primary election is on Tuesday, June 9. Ballot drop-off will be accepted at the City Hall vote center from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. from June 1-8, and from 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. on Election Day. In person voting will be available at City Hall from 8:00 a.m.- 5:00 p.m. from June 1-5, and from 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. on June 9. At the Heritage Park Senior Facility, in person voting will be available on June 3 and 4 from 9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m., on June 5 from 9:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m., and on June 9 from 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. Don't forget to vote YES on Question 1 to keep our parks beautiful!
