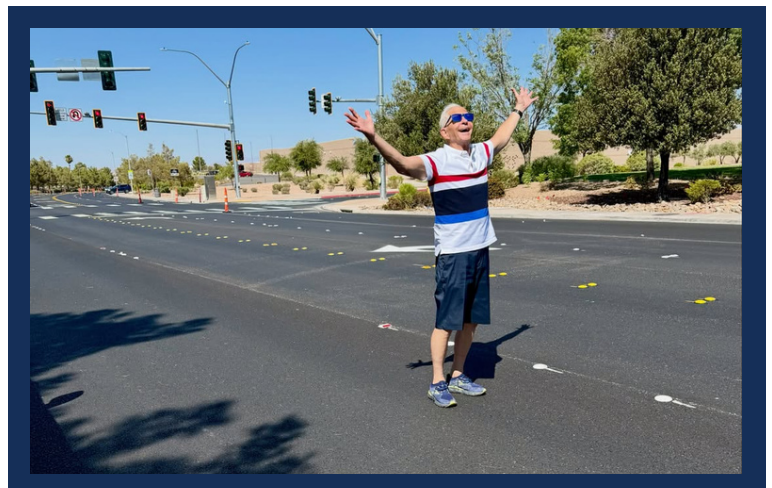
First Day of School

Carnegie St. Repaving and Traffic Signal

Carnegie Street has been repaved from Paseo Verde to Green Valley Parkway (Sunridge Heights), and a new traffic signal was installed to improve visibility, traffic flow, and safety for drivers and pedestrians in the area. I am always proud of investments in our infrastructure that help to keep our growing community moving safely, especially ahead of the busy school year.



Construction Updates

Weeks of August 23 & 30

Expect the following traffic impacts between 9:00 p.m. - 6:00 a.m. nightly from Sunday night to Friday morning:

I-215

Speed limit reduced to 55mph

St Rose Pkwy to Stephanie St

- *Asphalt and concrete paving, upgrading of high-mast lighting to LED, storm drain install, removals, retaining and sound walls, ITS, excavation for widening*
 - Lane reductions at night, as needed

Ramps

I-215/Green Valley Pkwy on-ramps and off ramps

- *Ramp realignment, retaining walls, ramp widening*
 - Lane restrictions

I-215/Stephanie St on-ramps and off-ramps

- *Retaining walls and ramp widening*
 - Lane restrictions

I-215/Valle Verde Dr on-ramps and off-ramps

- *Ramp realignment and retaining walls*
 - Lane restrictions

I-215/Pecos Rd/St Rose Pkwy on-ramps and off-ramps

- *Paving, sound walls, traffic signals, ramp realignment*
 - Lane restrictions

Surface Streets

Green Valley Pkwy, Corporate Circle to south of Village Walk Dr

- *Pedestrian bridge foundations, traffic signals, NV Energy Work*
 - Lane restrictions
 - May be reduced to one lane at night (9pm-6am)
 - Pedestrians detoured to northbound Green Valley Pkwy. See website for details.

Bike Paths & Trails

I-215 Trail, Valle Verde Dr to St Rose Pkwy

- *Soundwall installation*
 - Long-term closure, including trail connection at Dos Escuelas Park
 - Detoured to Paseo Verde Pkwy

I-215 Trail, Arroyo Grande Blvd to Stephanie St

- *Retaining walls*
 - Long-term closure
 - Detoured to Paseo Verde Pkwy

Community Day of Service



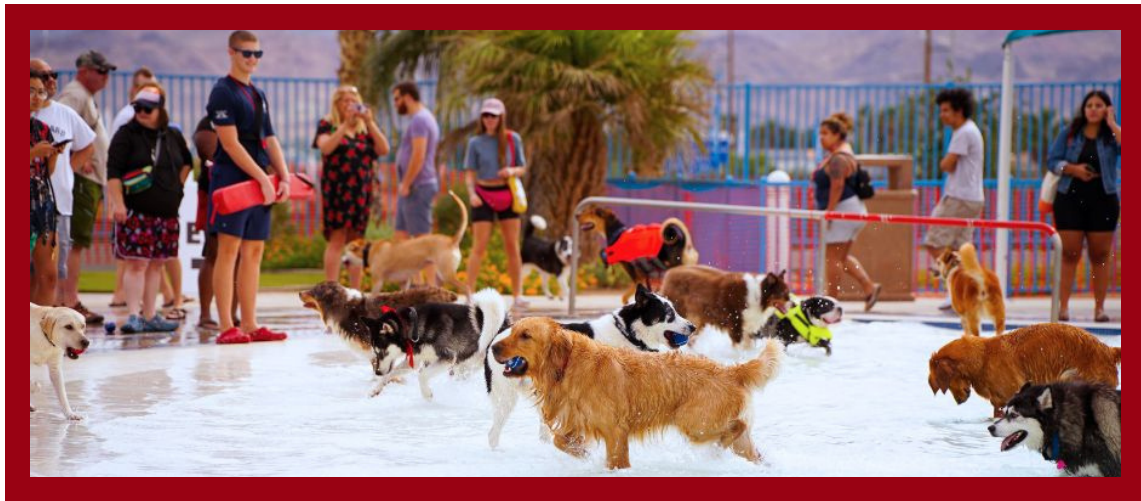
